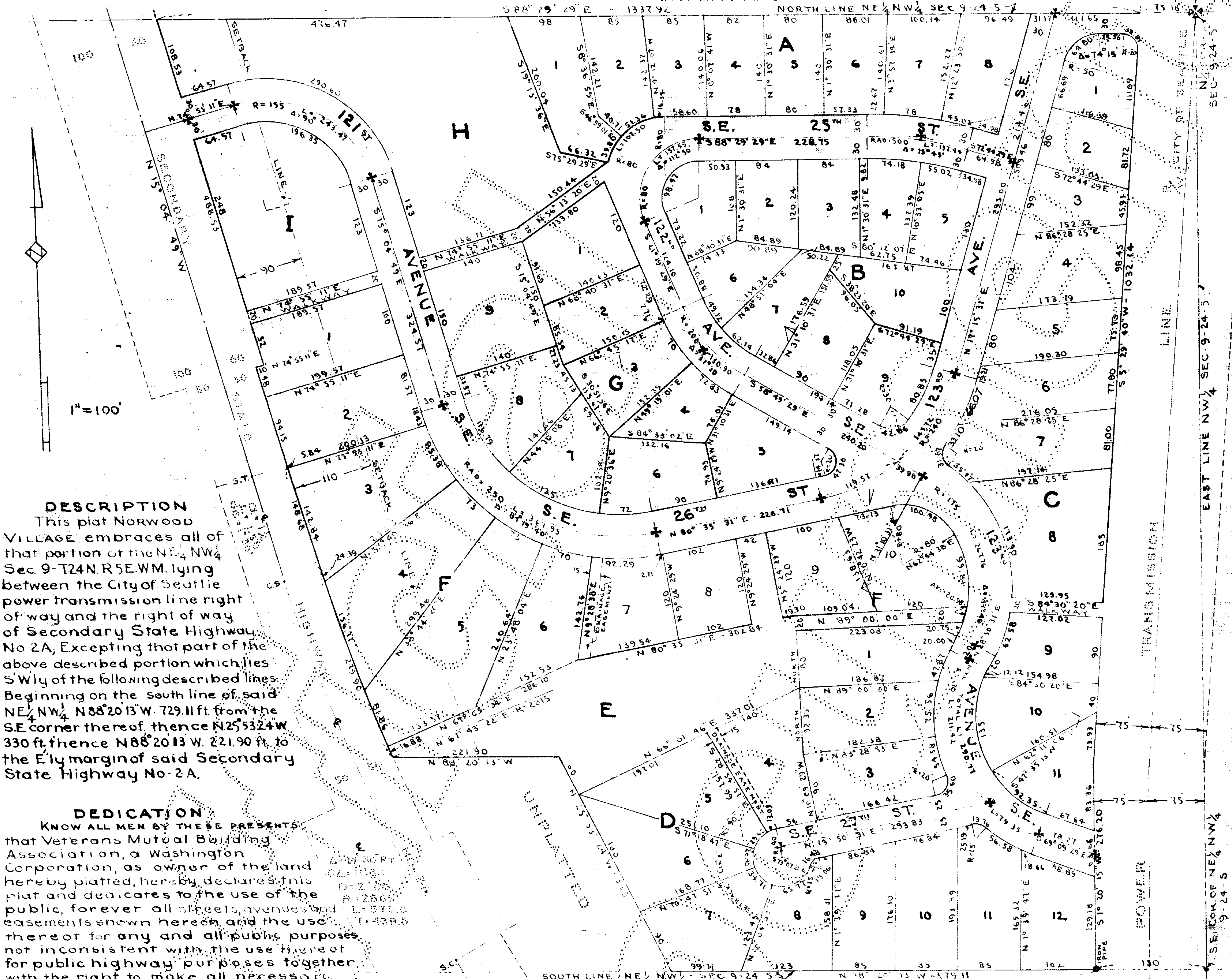

DESCRIPTION

This plat NORWOOD VILLAGE embraces all of that portion of the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec 9-T24N R5E.W.M. lying between the City of Seattle power transmission line right of way and the right of way of Secondary State Highway No 2A, Excepting that part of the above described portion which lies S'Wly of the following described lines. Beginning on the south line of said NE 1/4 NW 1/4 N 88° 20' 13" W. 729.11 ft. from the SE corner thereof, thence N 25° 53' 24" W. 330 ft., thence N 88° 20' 13" W. 221.90 ft. to the Ely margin of said Secondary State Highway No. 2A.

DEDICATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that Veterans Mutual Building Association, a Washington Corporation, as owner of the land hereby platted, hereby declares this plat and dedicates to the use of the public, forever all streets, avenues and easements shown hereon and the use thereof for any and all public purposes not inconsistent with the use thereof for public highway purposes together with the right to make all necessary slopes for cuts or fills upon the lots or blocks shown hereon, in the original and reasonable grading of all such streets, avenues and alleys shown hereon.
