

Norwood Village Board Meeting Minutes

1. Minutes: Approved as changed.

2. Treasurer's Report:

- The bills for the dues were sent out in the first week of March.
- 16 owners have already paid the dues.
- Lisa was informed by Karen that the bill to the pool is also sent out.

3. Old Business:

- Topic 60th Anniversary Party:
Action: Bob will ask, whether it would be possible to use the pool area for our 60th Anniversary Party in August.

4. New Business:

- Topic: Village position on owners or tenants owning dangerous animals.
There is an actual threat caused by two pit bull terriers in our neighborhood.
Renters, living close to Norwood Village Park, are the owners of these dogs, which have already been able to escape. Several people were threatened by them and the police were called to take care of the dogs that day.

Bob contacted the owner of this house and got the information that according to the lease contract, the tenants would not be allowed to own dogs.

Action: Bob will send letters to the direct neighbors of the dog owners and suggest calling 911 every time they feel threatened by these animals.

The second reason to contact this houses' owner is the amount of \$ 930 outstanding dues. Bob has been told that the check is already in the mail.

- Topic: Use of Norwood Village Pool for Norwood Residents.
Bob sent them an email asking whether there is a possibility to buy single tickets for using the pool.
As Don told us, there are special possibilities for Norwood Village neighbors to get reduced prices for season tickets.
- Topic: Trimming trees near power lines.
Two trees in the southwest corner of the pools' parking lot are starting to get near the power lines. Before City Light cuts them down, we would like to trim them back. Don has already got one bid of \$320.
Action: Don/Bob will get a second quote for trimming the trees.
- Topic: Costs for maintenance work at Lot F1 from May to October.
Action: Lisa will copy one of Dales' reviews of the hours he works each month on this area.
